Protecting God's Children is an awareness program designed to create a safer environment for our children. The purpose of the program is to make every adult employee and volunteer in the diocese aware of the issues surrounding child sexual abuse. This awareness session helps adults learn to recognize and respond to the warning signs of abuse.

Anyone who is planning to assist in any of our volunteer programs this year will be expected to attend one of the scheduled seminars, if you have not already attended. (Coaches, holiday party helpers, art moms, learning center volunteers, pizza helpers, field trip chaperones, Religious Education teachers, guest readers etc.)

Additionally a criminal background check will be required.

If you already attended a session in a previous year, you do not need to attend again.
